Dedication of St. Michael the Archangel

Thursday, September 29

8:00 am Low Mass | 6:00 p.m. High Mass

St. Michael's name - *Quis ut Deus?* or **Who is Like God?** --this was the war-cry of the good angels in the battle fought in heaven against the enemy and his followers.

Four times his name is recorded in Scripture:

Daniel 10:13, Gabriel says to Daniel, "The Angel of the kingdom of the Persians resisted me...and, behold Michael, one of the chief princes, came to help me...and none is my helper in all these things, but Michael your prince."

Daniel 12, the Angel speaking of the end of the world and the Antichrist says: "At that time shall Michael rise up, the great prince, who standeth for the children of thy people."

Catholic Epistle of St. Jude: "When Michael the Archangel, disputing with the devil, contended about the body of Moses," etc.

Apocalypse 12:7, "And there was a great battle in heaven, Michael and his angels fought with the dragon." St. John speaks here of the great conflict at the end of time.

Following these Scriptural passages then, Christian tradition assigns to St. Michael four functions:

- * **To fight against Satan.**
- * **To rescue the souls of the faithful from the power of the enemy, especially at the hour of death.**
- * **To be the champion of God's people, the Jews in the Old Law, the Christians in the New Testament, making him, therefore, patron of the Church.**
- * **To call away from the Earth men's souls bringing them to judgment.**

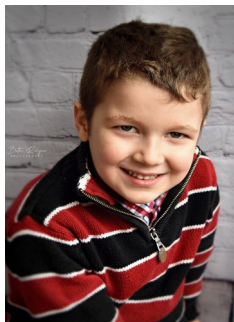
