OH MY GOD

The Holy Spirit revealed Himself at the Baptism of Jesus and on the day of Pentecost, when He was bestowed on the Apostles, in the shape of tongues of fire.

The Holy Trinity is a deep mystery. It is the heart of our salvation. Can our human strength reach the hidden source?

God is, at the same time, one and three. This statement is difficult to accept by those who don't have faith. It seems absurd and contradictory to Jews and Muslims. It is terribly abstract and quite far from the practical experiences of so many catechists, who usually skip any reflection on it.

The mystery of the Trinity is inaccessible because faith is not limited to our little thinking. Faith gives us God, in all his work, and not just through excerpts or quotes. We don't invent it, we receive it. Faith is not discovered through human experience. Faith is told, announced, confessed. Confessors of the faith are the loudspeakers of God.

"Go, baptize all nations", Jesus says. God the Father is mercy, the Son is the Lamb, God the Holy Ghost is the dove. The Father is the source, the Son is the river, and the Holy Ghost is the current.

And you, who are you? You are a sign of the Trinity in a secular world. You are a preacher, a loudspeaker of the greatness of God, the Trinity.

Month of the Sacred Heart

Devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus is one of the most popular Catholic devotions. Although it was beloved in previous centuries, Jesus appeared to St. Margaret Mary Alacoque in 1673, showing her a vision of the now-famous image of His Sacred Heart, surrounded by flames. He said to her: "My Heart is so full of love for men that It can no longer contain the flames of Its burning love. I must discover to men the treasures of My Heart and save them from perdition." She was given the special mission to spread devotion to His Sacred Heart throughout the Church. Jesus gave St. Margaret Mary many promises associated with this devotion, and requested that a feast day in honor of His Sacred Heart be instituted on the Friday after the Octave of Corpus Christi. In 1856, the Feast of the Sacred Heart was spread to the Universal Church, and in 1899 Pope Leo XIII solemnly consecrated all mankind to the Sacred Heart of Jesus, calling it "the great act" of his pontificate.

A century ago, on Trinity Sunday

At that time a young, 22 year-old girl, suffering from tuberculosis, wrote a letter to the Trinity. She offered herself as a Victim of Holocaust to God's Merciful Love.

"O My God! Most Blessed Trinity, I desire to Love You and make You Loved, to work for the glory of Holy Church by saving souls on earth and liberating those suffering in purgatory. I desire to accomplish Your will perfectly and to reach the degree of glory You have prepared for me in Your Kingdom. I desire, in a word, to be a saint, but I feel my helplessness and I beg You, O my God! to be Yourself my Sanctity!"

"In the evening of this life, I shall appear before You with empty hands, for I do not ask You, Lord, to count my works. All our justice is stained in Your eyes. I wish, then, to be clothed in Your own Justice and to receive from Your Love the eternal possession of Yourself. I want no other Throne, no other Crown but You, my Beloved!"

"I want, O my Beloved, at each beat of my heart to renew this offering to You an infinite number of times, until the shadows having disappeared I may be able to tell You of my Love in an Eternal Face to Face!"

She signed this prayer: Marie, Francoise, Therese of the Child Jesus and the Holy Face, unworthy Carmelite religious.
