An excessive lust for money may crowd out our attendance at Mass and the Sacraments, or distract us from proper devotion when we do attend. It might cause us to refuse to share our goods with the poor, even though they be in great need. And, of course, excessive concern for material things might lead to covetousness or even outright theft. Our Lord is simply telling us--in very beautiful language--that we must keep things in perspective.

The birds of the air and the lilies of the field certainly glorify God with their great beauty and majesty. We too glorify God when we complete our daily duties with His honor in mind. Without His honor in mind, our labors will be crass and without glory. But with God's honor as our motivation, our glory will be like the lilies of the field and the birds of the air.
