Why doesn't the Easter Vigil fulfill my Sunday obligation this year? - Because the Mass will begin before 4pm, and only Saturday Masses starting at 4pm or later fulfill the Sunday obligation.

Why start so early? — The Traditional Rite of the Easter Vigil begins fittingly earlier, because the ceremony ends with Vespers (evening prayer), rather than Lauds (morning prayer), as it does in the new rite.

Why not begin a bit later, so that the ceremony can fulfill the Sunday obligation? — The Vigil was not conceived as a replacement for Easter Sunday, nor are they the same Masses. The Vigil starting late enough can only fulfill the Sunday obligation because of the general concession that Saturday evening Mass can fulfill your obligation. Easter is the Sunday of Sundays, and should be privileged. Like Holy Thursday and Good Friday, attendance at the Vigil is devotional.

### Sound System and New Vestibule Doors

As of the date of this bulletin's submission, barring any unforeseen circumstances, the sound system installation should have been completed, and the vestibule doors are scheduled to be installed March 25 through 27.

### SACRAMENTS CORNER

### Are you registered?

If you consider St. Leo Oratory as your parish, be sure to register using the forms available at the entrances. Active, registered members fulfill their Sunday obligation weekly or at least regularly at the Oratory, and contribute to the Oratory according to their means.

### Conversion to the Catholic Faith

Those who desire to become Catholic are encouraged to contact the rector of the Oratory by phone (614–443–7685) or email (stleo@icksp.org).

### Infant Baptism

Parents requesting infant baptism for their child should be active, registered members of the Oratory (otherwise, permission from your pastor must be obtained). Infants should be baptized within the first three weeks after birth (Code of Canon Law, 867 §1). Contacting the rector a few weeks before the child's birth is strongly recommended.

### First Communion & Confirmation

Parents should be active, registered members of the Oratory (otherwise, permission from your pastor must be obtained). Contact the rector for information on preparation and enrolling your child for the next First Communion or Confirmation ceremony.

### Extreme Unction (Anointing of the Sick)

If an individual is facing a dangerous illness or even death, call 614–443–7685.

### Holy Matrimony

Ordinarily, at least one party must be an active, registered member of the Oratory. Couples desirous of marrying at the Oratory should contact the rector a minimum of seven months prior to their desired wedding date for more information. The Oratory wedding policy is available upon request.
