Please note that starting this week, we will proceed to the refurbishing of the six front entrance doors, including their frames and transoms located on the North Elevation of St. Joseph church building. This project is a continuation of the Historic Renewal Project and it is also in preparation for the celebration of the 150th Anniversary of the Dedication of the church building in 2023.
