TABERNACLE DOORS UPDATE

The gold-leaf is on, and the background, vines, and grapes are painted in. The angels will be painted soon. After they have dried over several days, a temporary retouch varnish will be applied so that the doors can be hung. After one year a damar varnish will be applied to protect the images from dust and smoke.

SUNDAY ORGAN CLASS

Our Music Director, Michael Semaan, is planning to start a five-week summer organ class open to children and adults, of any age, who are interested in learning more about the pipe organ and/or possibly learning to play or progress in their playing. It begins next Sunday (July 31) and will meet for forty-five minutes to an hour on Sundays at 1 PM up in the choir loft and should cover the most important musical, liturgical, and pastoral principles required of any Church musician. The individual cost, per session, to cover time/materials, is five dollars. Private organ lessons also later could be arranged, on an individual basis.
