

Our Lord appeared five times on the last day, Saturday: once to Magdalene alone, and again to her when she was returning to the disciples with the other women, when they approached and held our Lord's feet (Matt 28:9). The third time was to the two disciples on the road to Emmaus (Luke 24:13). The fourth time was to Simon Peter. The fifth time as related in today's Gospel. This is the reason why we sing: this is the day which the Lord has made; let us rejoice and be glad in it! for eight days. Very early on, Christians began to celebrate the Lord's Day on Sunday and no anymore on Saturday. The New Manna, the new bread of Heaven, Christ our Pasch, the Panis Angelicus, manifests Himself in His glorious resurrection and ascension into Heaven. Let us then keep the Sabbath holy!
