FROM OUR VICE-RECTOR, REV. CANON SEQUEIRA

Dear faithful,

The Gospel (Lk 18,9-14) presents us with another fundamental characteristic of the Christian soul: humility. Humility is of great importance because it is the virtue which clears the ground to make room for grace and charity. The publican of today's Gospel is a poor man who knows he has sinned, and he is aware of his moral wretchedness. He does not possess charity either, because sin is an obstacle to it, but he is humble, very humble, and he trusts in the mercy of God. "O God, be merciful to me, a sinner!" And God who loves to bend down to the humble, justifies him at that very moment; his humility has drawn down upon him the grace of the Most High. Saint Augustine has said: "God prefers humility in things that are done badly, rather than pride in those which are done well!" We are not justified by our virtues and our good works, but by grace and charity, which the Holy Spirit diffuses in our hearts, "according as He wills," yes, but always in proportion to our humility.


