#### FROM OUR PASTOR, REV. CANON COMMINS

"Living the truth in charity". Don Marmion wrote: it is this feature of human acts fully free but in accord with our nature and the final end of our creation, and morally good in consequence, which ought to be the primary mark of our works in the sight of God. "He who says that he knows Him, and does not keep His commandments, is a liar and the truth is not in him". "In Charity", which is to say, first and foremost, in that fundamental, essential, charity which makes us relate entirely to God, finding in Him the Supreme Good we prefer to any other good; this is a description of the fruit of the grace which makes us pleasing to God to the point of being His Children.
