#### FROM THE RECTOR'S DESK



Dear Faithful,

In the parable of the wheat and the weeds, Jesus does not tell us to compromise with evil but He tells us to endure tribulations with the wisdom with which He Himself endured them. Was there not a traitor among the Apostles? Jesus anticipates our impatience, describing His Kingdom as a mixture of good and bad or weeds among the wheat. It is a lesson of realism: if I expect others to bear with my defects, I must likewise bear with theirs. Moreover, we should consider that, whereas cockle cannot be changed into wheat, it is always possible for the wicked to be converted and to become good. The Good Thief and Saint Peter, who had denied Jesus, converted.

Only if we keep our eyes fixed on Jesus, we will be able to surmount all the difficulties we meet daily. Saint Paul tells us to “put on a heart of mercy, kindness, humility, meekness and patience.” If we strive to live like that we will be able to overcome the suffering that come our way and that is imitation of Christ.

## **Our Lady of Lourdes**

Friday, February 11th, is the feast of Our Lady of Lourdes. In our church, this apparition of the Blessed Virgin Mary is represented in the 3rd stained glass window from the front, on the Epistle side. The window shows Mary appearing in 1858 to Bernadette Soubirous, who was only 14 years old. In all, Mary appeared to Bernadette 18 times. The site, in Southern France, has become one of the most visited pilgrimage sites in the world. In the March 25th apparition, Our Lady said to Bernadette "I am the Immaculate Conception". This was a positively stunning statement because the dogma of the Immaculate Conception had only been declared by Pope Pius IX in 1854. The Immaculate Conception of Mary is depicted in the stained glass window on the Gospel side of our sanctuary.
