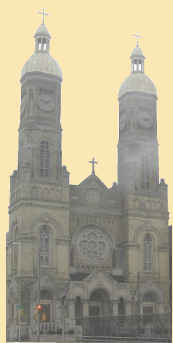
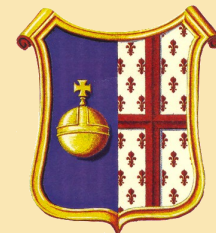

MAY LITANY

The litany for May is that of the Blessed Virgin Mary. It is also known as the Litany of Loreto. We honor Mary as the mother of Our Lord and as the mother of the Church. May has been the month to honor mothers going all the way back to the ancient Greeks who dedicated the month of May to Artemis, the goddess of fecundity. The Romans had a goddess called Flora, which is related to the flowers of Spring. This litany recalls all the various titles of Mary, many of which are familiar to us all. This is a good litany to recite out loud, perhaps as a family, each day during this month of Mary.

Our Lady of Fatima

This Friday, May 13th, is the 105th anniversary of the initial apparition of Our Lady at Fatima, Portugal. The abbreviated story of Fatima is told in a yellow covered booklet available in the vestibule and in the south pamphlet rack. A blue insert in that booklet explains First Saturday devotion.

Our Lady of Fatima is represented in our church by a stained glass window, on the epistle side, 2nd from the front, where she is shown with Blessed Francisco, Blessed Jacinta and Sister Lucia. She is also in a ceiling painting, on the gospel side, near the choir loft.

APPARITIONS AT FATIMA

The Blessed Virgin Mary appeared to three peasant children in 1917 at Fatima, Portugal. It is one of the best known apparitions which have been approved by the Church.

Mary appeared on the 13th of the months May through October of that year. Each appearance has its own individual character and is good to read about. The yellow booklet in the vestibule and south pamphlet rack gives the abbreviated story. It is worth reading, especially on the 13th of each month.

A blue insert in the yellow booklet explains the First Saturday practices as requested by the Our Lady of Fatima. It is recommended that everyone follow this practice throughout their life.
