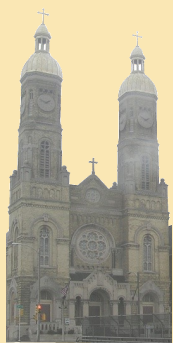
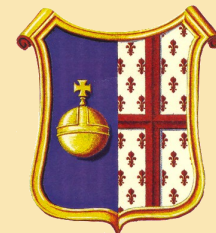

ENTHRONEMENT OF THE SACRED HEART

June is the month for doing the Enthronement of the Sacred Heart in your home. All you have to do is request it and one of our priests will contact you to set the date.

There is a display in the south vestibule with pamphlets explaining the enthronement and application forms. If you are interested, please complete one of the forms and get it to the parish office. You can drop off the completed form yourself, drop it in the Sunday collection or leave it on the table in the vestibule.

ROGATION DAYS

The Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday preceding Ascension Thursday are called the Rogation Days. It is on these three days that the litany of the saints is recited, usually in procession. These days are also called the Minor Litanies, in contrast to April 25th which is called the Greater Litanies. The purpose of the Minor Litanies is both to prepare for the Ascension and to pray for good crops. This tradition goes back at least to the 5th century, with a procession in Rome that ended at St. Peter's for Mass.

Our practice, at St. Stanislaus, is to begin the rosary early (11:30 AM) in order to leave time for the litany of the saints to be recited before the start of Mass. The litany is recited during an indoor procession around the church.

Friday Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament

Holy Hour every Friday after the 6:30 pm Low Mass until 8:30 pm.

Pamphlet Racks

At St. Stanislaus we have two pamphlet racks...one in the north vestibule and one in the south vestibule. Each has its own set of pamphlets and holy cards, so you might want to visit both. There is no charge for the items in either rack. The items are provided by the Holy Name Society.

In the north rack, there are green scapulars, brown scapulars, Holy Face medals and St. Benedict medals. In the south rack are some holy cards and other items in Spanish together with booklets on Ecu-menism, Fatima and The Conversion of Rattisbonne.

The only item which appears in both pamphlet racks is the litany of the month, which is recommended to take home and recite as a family.
