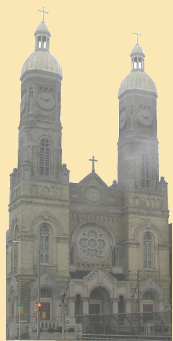
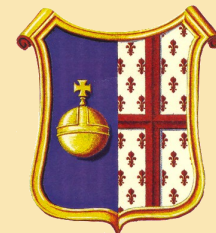

TRINITY SUNDAY

This Sunday, June 12th is Trinity Sunday. The Trinity is a mystery of our faith. We believe in the Trinity and know that it lives in the soul of each person who is in a state of sanctifying grace. But it is not easy to visualize.

In our church, we can see the dove of the Holy Ghost looking down over the high altar. Jesus Christ is present in the tabernacle on the altar and is depicted on the crucifix. We do not have an image of God the Father.

In our creed, we profess belief in God the Father Almighty, creator of heaven and earth. He is also our creator.

But, to see an image of Him, you might have to look to an artist such as Michelangelo, who shows God creating Adam on the Sistine Chapel ceiling.
