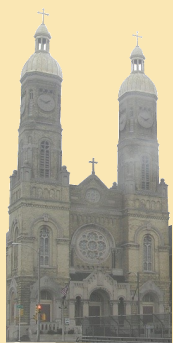

St. Peter

This Wednesday is the feast day of SS. Peter and Paul. In our church, St. Peter is represented in a medallion above the sanctuary. His is the one on the left. He is represented holding keys which indicate his authority over the Church.

St. Peter, one of the original 12 apostles, became our first Pope. After the Ascension of Jesus, Peter lead the Church in Jerusalem, Antioch, Corinth and eventually Rome. He was crucified in Rome about the year 64 and his tomb is directly under the high altar in St. Peter's basilica.

St. Paul

In our church, St. Paul is also represented in a medallion above the sanctuary. His is the one on the right. He is shown holding a sword, the instrument of his death.

St. Paul is considered an apostle, although not one of the original 12. After being a staunch persecutor of the early Church, he was converted by Jesus, who appeared to him on the road to Damascus. St. Paul wrote many of the books of the New Testament. He was arrested on the last of his travels and taken to Rome, where he was martyred by beheading, also about the year 64. His tomb is in the church of St. Paul's Outside the Walls.

ENTHRONEMENT OF THE SACRED HEART

June is the month for doing the Enthronement of the Sacred Heart in your home. All you have to do is request it and one of our priests will contact you to set the date.

There is a display in the south vestibule with pamphlets explaining the enthronement and application forms. If you are interested, please complete one of the forms and get it to the parish office. You can drop off the completed form yourself, drop it in the Sunday collection or leave it on the table in the vestibule.
