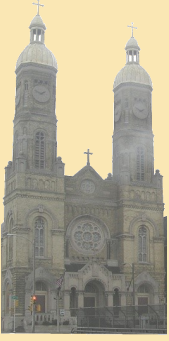

St. Cyril

Thursday, July 7th, is the feast day of SS Cyril and Methodius. St. Cyril is represented in our church by a medallion. It is the 2nd medallion from the front, on the Epistle side. St. Cyril died in Rome in the year 869, probably before he was consecrated a bishop. He and his brother, St. Methodius, were from Thessalonica and preached in Moravia, which is now part of the Czech Republic.

St. Methodius

St. Methodius shares Thursday, July 7th, with his brother, St. Cyril. St. Methodius is also represented in our church by a medallion. It is the front medallion on the Epistle side. St. Methodius was a bishop in Moravia and preached in Slavonic, which is an ancient language and the base language for much of eastern Europe. He died in 884. Cyril and Methodius are credited with pulling the eastern and western churches together.

ENTHRONEMENT OF THE SACRED HEART

June is the month for doing the Enthronement of the Sacred Heart in your home. All you have to do is request it and one of our priests will contact you to set the date.
