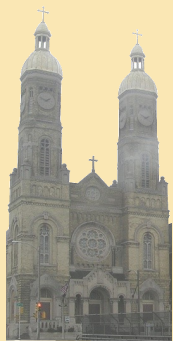

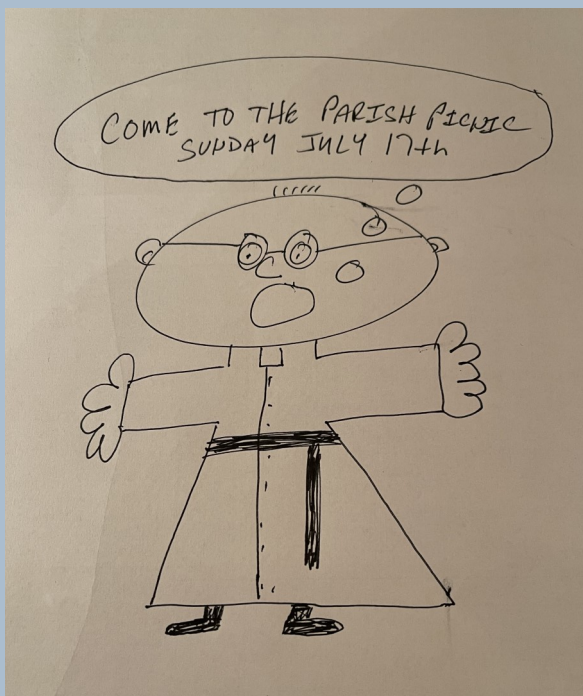

Father John Rausch, Obituary

Father Rausch was born on July 23, 1922 and died on June 30th of this year. He celebrated his 75th anniversary of ordination in June.

Father had been assigned at eight different parishes but ended up his priestly career helping out the Traditional Latin Mass Community both at St. Mary Help of Christians and at St. Stanislaus.

There is a wake scheduled for Thursday, July 14th, at Church and Chapel Funeral Home, 15250 W. National Ave. Viewing time is 4-8 PM with the rosary at 7:00 PM.

A Mass of Christian burial will be at Holy Apostles Church, 16000 W. National Ave., on Friday, July 15th. Viewing will be 10-11:45 AM with Mass at noon, Archbishop ListECKI celebrating. Burial will be at Holy Apostles Cemetery.

There will also be a Requiem Mass at St. Stanislaus on Wednesday, July 13th at noon.

F A T I M A S T A T U E

We have a traveling statue of Our Lady of Fatima. It visits homes, usually for 2-3 week period of time. Anyone can request a visit and get on the list. SHRINES IN WISCONSIN

Our State has three primary shrines, all dedicated to the Blessed Virgin Mary. The first is the National Shrine of Mary, Help of Christians in Hubertus. It is a basilica situated on over 400 acres and hosts over 500,000 people each year. We typically have our annual pilgrimage there.

The second is the Shrine of Our Lady of Good Help in New Franken, outside of Green Bay. Our Lady appeared to a young Belgian immigrant there in 1859. It is the only approved Marian apparition site anywhere in the United States.

The third is the Shrine of Our Lady of Guadalupe in La Crosse. This shrine was started by Cardinal Raymond Burke, who is a close friend of the Institute. It has a magnificent Shrine Church and many additional areas of devotion.

FATIMA SHRINE

We are very blessed in Milwaukee with a Marian Shrine dedicated to Our Lady of Fatima. It is located on 68th Street between I-94 and Bluemound Rd. The main shrine consists of Our Lady, Lucia, Francisco and Jacinta in a pastoral setting with sheep.

Some other items of interest are beautiful carvings representing the 15 mysteries of the rosary and various statues and monuments.
