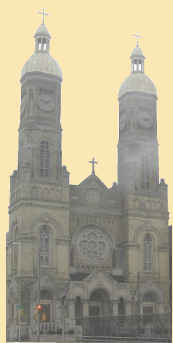

OCTOBER ~ MONTH OF THE HOLY ROSARY

The Rosary is a crown of roses. In the middle ages, some monks who were not priests, could not read. Instead of reciting the 150 psalms included in the Divine Office, as the other monks did, they said 150 Our Fathers. In the 11th century, this changed to 150 Hail Marys and was known as Our Lady's Psalter. St. Dominic received the rosary in its present form directly from the Blessed Virgin Mary in the year 1214. Then, in 1569 Pope St. Pius V set the fifteen mysteries. The name "rosary" was first used later in the same century.

When the Catholic Church faces perils from outside or internal troubles, Popes and saints have always urged the Christian people to pray with their rosary. The rosary is the weapon of those who want Christ to win. The Church has applied indulgences for reciting the rosary, the most important is a plenary indulgence for saying the rosary in church. In Saint Stanislaus, it is every day!
