Immaculate Conception

This Tuesday, December 8th, is the feast of the Immaculate Conception, which is represented in our church by the stained glass window in the sanctuary, on the Gospel side. Our Lady is shown standing on a globe covered with 12 stars, with the crescent moon behind, and is crushing a snake, a symbol of the devil. This imagery comes out of the book of the Apocalypse. She is holding a white lily, a symbol of purity. The Immaculate Conception of Mary refers to the fact that she was conceived without original sin.
