Dear faithful.

In the days following His Resurrection from the dead, Our Lord prepared His Apostles for their coming ministry by instructing them in all the teachings of the Faith. If He could say to them at the Last Supper: "I will not now call you Servants; but I have called you my Friends: because all things whatsoever I have heard from my Father, I have made known unto you;" how must He not treat them now that he has repeated to them the whole of his teaching, given them the Word of God, and is on the eve of sending the Holy Spirit upon them, in order to perfect their understanding, and give them power to preach the Gospel to the entire world?

One of the chief means by which the Apostles communicated the Word of God in their epistles was the remembrance of God's instructions in the Old Testament, of which Christ is the fulfillment. In Romans 1:17, for example, when St. Paul tells us that "the just man liveth by faith," he is repeating the teaching found in the Book of the Prophet Habacuc: "the just shall live in his faith." (Hab. 2:4).

If we would nurture our faith, then we must be versed in the Scriptures. In his 1893 encyclical on Sacred Scripture, *Providentissimus Deus*, Pope Leo XIII exhorted all Catholics to the regular reading of Scripture, for it is through Scripture, and particularly the Gospels, that we come to know Our Lord more intimately. A particularly recommendable edition of the Bible in English is the *Douay-Rheims*, the English translation of St. Jerome's Latin Vulgate. Hopefully it has a place on your bookshelf!

Our good friend <u>Fr. Robert McTeigue</u>, <u>SJ</u> will offer the 12:30 Mass this Sunday, as I have been asked to help at a parish in Vacaville this Sunday. Please be sure to thank Fr. McTeigue!

Could you please keep a **special intention** of mine in your prayers? It would be greatly appreciated. You surely know by now that the prayers of the faithful go a long way in supporting their priests. Your generosity will not be forgotten by the Lord.

Have you ever considered that the Good Lord may be calling you to serve Him in a concrete way at your local parish? Next Thursday, April 25 is the <u>Feast of St. Mark, Apostle and Martyr</u>. The 25th day of April is also traditionally the day on which the penitential Rogation Procession takes place and farmers' fields are blessed. This tradition seems to be of very early origin, and were introduced to appease God's wrath, justly stoked by our repeated sins. Not infre-
