

we will be hosting a St. Mary Oratory Women's Group Social in St. Joseph's Hall! Canon


O'Connor will give a spiritual presentation and afterwards we will spend time together getting to know one another and playing games. We ask you bring a monetary donation to help defray

PRECEPT ON FASTING & ABSTINENCE

Catholics between the ages of 18 and 59 are obliged to FAST on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. On these days only one full meal is permitted. Up to two colations (smaller meals which added together would not equal a full meal) are allowed if needed. All Catholics 14 years old and older are obliged to ABSTAIN from meat on Ash Wednesday, Good Friday and all the Fridays of Lent.

GOD & HIS PERFECTION

Lesson 2 from the Baltimore Catechism (con't)

8. What do we mean when we say that God is the Supreme Being?

When we say that God is the Supreme Being we mean that He is above all creatures, the selfexisting and infinitely perfect Spirit.

I am the First, and I am the Last, and besides me there is no God. (Isaiah 44:6)

9. What is a spirit?

A spirit is a being that has understanding and free will, but no body, and will never die.

To whom then have you likened God? Or what image will you make for Him? (Isaiah 40:18)

10. What do we mean when we say that God is selfexisting?

When we say that God is self-existing we mean that He does not owe His existence to any other being.

I am who am. (Exodus 3:14)

11. What do we mean when we say that God is infinitely perfect?

When we say that God is infinitely perfect we mean that He has all perfections without limit.

Great is the Lord, and greatly to be praised; and of his greatness there is no end. (Psalm 144:3)
