# Catechism Corner

THE COMMANDMENTS OF THE CHURCH; THE FIRST AND SECOND COMMANDMENTS

**Lesson 21 from the Baltimore Catechism** 

279. Whence has the Catholic Church the right to make

The Catholic Church has the right to make laws from Jesus Christ, who said to the apostles, the first bishops of His Church: "Whatever you bind on earth shall be bound also in heaven."

Amen I say to you, whatever you bind on earth shall be bound also in heaven; and whatever you loose on earth shall be loosed also in heaven. (Matthew 18:18)

280. By whom is this right to make laws exercised? This right to make laws is exercised by the bishops, the successors of the apostles, and especially by the Pope, who as the successor of the chief of the apostles, Saint Peter, has the right to make laws for

the Universal Church. And I say to thee, thou art Peter, and upon this rock I

will build my Church, and the gates of hell shall not prevail against it. (Matthew 16:18)

281. Which are the chief commandments, or laws, of the Church?

The chief commandments, or laws, of the Church are these six:

To assist at Mass on all Sundays and holydays of obligation.

To fast and to abstain on the days appointed. To confess our sins at least once a year.

To receive Holy Communion during the Easter time. To contribute to the support of the Church.

To observe the laws of the Church concerning

A Catholic who through his own fault misses Mass on a Sunday or holy day of obligation commits a mortal sin.

Keep you my sabbath; for it is holy unto you. (Exodus 31:14)

283. Which are the holy days of obligation in the **United States?** 

The holy days of obligation in the United States are these:

**Christmas Day (December 25)** 

The Octave of the Nativity (January 1)

The Assumption (August 15) All Saints' Day (November 1)

The Immaculate Conception (December 8)
