Act of Adoration and Reparation Before the Blessed Sacrament



I adore Thee profoundly, O my Jesus, in Thy sacramental form; I acknowledge Thee to be true God and true Man, and by this act of adoration I intend to atone for the coldness of so many Christians who pass before Thy churches and sometimes before the very Tabernacle in which

Thou art pleased to remain at all hours with loving impatience to give Thyself to Thy faithful people, and do not so much as bend the knee before Thee, and who, by their indifference proclaim that they grow weary of this heavenly manna, like the people of Israel in the wilderness. I offer Thee in reparation for this grievous negligence, the Most Precious Blood which Thou didst shed from Thy Five Wounds, and especially from Thy Sacred Side, and entering therein, I repeat a thousand times with true recollection of spirit:

O Sacrament most holy!
O Sacrament divine!
All praise and all thanksgiving be every moment Thine

Eucharistic Adoration in Reparation for Public Sins After the Noon Mass until 2:00 p.m. Monday, February 20 – Tuesday, February 21

In the encyclical, Miserentissimus Redemptor, Pope Pius XI spoke of the duty of reparation: "... if ...the creature's love should be given in return for the love of the Creator, another thing follows from this at once, namely that to the same uncre-

ated Love, if so be it has been neglected by forgetfulness or violated by offense, some sort of compensation must be rendered for the injury, and this debt is commonly called by the name of reparation". Reparation is a beautiful and essential element of our Catholic faith wherein some act of mortification is offered as a voluntary act of love to repair injustice.



Ash Wednesday

On Ash Wednesday, February 22, fasting and abstinence are required. The Church emphasizes the penitential nature of Ash Wednesday by calling us to fast and to abstain from meat, thus inviting us to mortification during Lent. Mortification concerns not only our spiritual reform but also concerns spiritual reparation. "Many sins wrong our neighbor. One must do what is possible in order to repair the harm (e.g., return stolen goods, restore the reputation of someone slandered, pay compensation for injuries). Simple justice requires as much."


