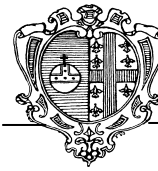

**St. Francis de Sales, Bishop, Confessor and Doctor**

Born on the border of Switzerland, into an old aristocratic family of Savoy, Francis of Sales became one of the foremost missionaries of the Catholic Restoration. He drew Calvinists to the Church by his Christ-like kindness; but after the winning of the heretics, the saint was very exacting in the direction of his converts. His writings are Christian classics in which he emphasizes the importance of a staunch Catholic laity, holding that it is an error to believe that piety is incompatible with any state of life. Francis of Sales was appointed bishop of Geneva in 1603. Seven years later, together with St. Jane de Chantal, he founded the Order of the Visitation. This holy and gentle apostle died in 1622.

**Introit:** *Ecc. 15: 5* In the midst of the Church the Lord opened his mouth: and filled him with the spirit of wisdom and understanding: He clothed him with a robe of glory.. (*Ps. 91: 2*) It is good to give praise to the Lord: and to sing to Thy Name, O Most High.

**Prayer :** O God, by whose gracious will blessed Francis, Thy confessor and bishop, became all things to all men, for the salvation of their souls; grant, we beseech Thee that being filled with the sweetness of Thy love we may, by the guidance of his counsels and by the aid of his merits, attain unto the joys of everlasting life.

**Epistle:** *II Timothy 4: 1-8* Dearly beloved, I charge thee, before God and Jesus Christ, Who shall judge the living and the dead, by His coming and His kingdom: preach the word: be instant in season, out of season: reprove, entreat, rebuke in all patience and doctrine. For there shall be a time when they will not endure sound doctrine, but according to their own desires they will heap to themselves teachers, having itching ears, and will indeed turn away from the truth, but will be turned into fables. But be thou vigilant, labour in all things, do the work of an evangelist, fulfill thy ministry. Be sober. For I am even now ready to be sacrificed. And the time of my dissolution is at hand. I have fought the good fight, I have finished my course, I have kept the faith. As to the rest, there is laid up for me a crown of justice, which the Lord, the just Judge, will render to me in that day: and not only to me, but to them also that love His coming.

**Gradual:** *Psalm 36: 30-31* The mouth of the just shall meditate wisdom, and his tongue shall speak judgment. The law of His God is in his heart: and his steps shall not be supplanted.

**Gospel:** *Matthew 5: 13-19* At that time, Jesus said to His disciples: You are the salt of the earth. But if the salt lose its savour, wherewith shall it be salted? Neither do men light a candle and put it under a bushel but upon a candlestick, that it may shine to all that are before men that they may see your good works, and glorify your Father, Who is in heaven. ### The Purification of the Blessed Virgin Mary

In the presentation of Jesus, and the purification of Mary, behold the humility of both. The Son of God could not be bound by a law of which He Himself was the author; the mother of God, who had conceived and brought forth her divine Child in so extraordinary a manner, might certainly have claimed exemption from the usages established for the rest of her sex. Still both of them submit and readily conform to the precepts of the law. O wonderful example! How loudly it condemns the want of submission of those who pay so little deference to the precepts of the Church, the sole design of which is to promote their salvation !

The presentation of Jesus and the purification of Mary are observed as a feast by the Church on the ad of February. It is called the feast of the Purification of the Blessed Virgin Mary, and is also known by the name of Candelmas Day, from the candles blessed before Mass, to remind us of Him whom Simeon was inspired to call the " Light to the revelation of the Gentiles." This feast was instituted by Pope Gelasius, A.D. 542.
