Dear faithful of the Shrine,

We would like to welcome Father Robert Nesbit OSB of the Monastery of Clear Creek in Oklahoma. Clear Creek is a daughter house from Fontgombault Monastery in France. He will be celebrating the 10 a.m. Solemn High Mass and will preach. Welcome Father Nesbit!

On the feast of the Holy Family, please join us today after the 10 am Mass for our annual Epiphany Pageant and reception. It will take place in First Presbyterian's Hall. (The first room on your left as you walk to the Upper Room)

A little note on the progress of the Shrine's restoration: *After a short break for the holidays work continues at the Shrine. Shop drawings of the roof truss steel were received and are being reviewed by Wiss Janney, Elstner Associates, Inc. Once reviewed and approved, the steel can start fabrication. Fabrication will take 6-8 weeks, just in time to erect steel when the spring starts to thaw. The cold temperatures of winter have put a hold on the tower repairs. The parapet has been protected for the winter.*

During this Christmastide, let us continue to pray to the Infant King for His intercession in our restoration efforts.

## Reminder for Mass Intentions

In order to accommodate all of the requests for Masses from the faithful who go to the Shrine and for those who are spiritually attached to the Shrine from the other parts of the world, please know that a limit of Masses would need to be established.

We kindly ask a limit of 10 public Mass intention requests, per family, per year.

Of those 10 public Mass intention requests, a limit of 3 public Sunday Mass intention requests per family, per year.

Public Mass requests would be scheduled on a first-come, first-served basis. For Masses that require a particular date, please schedule at least 6 months in advance.

In order to request private Mass intentions, please personally see one of the available Canons to schedule them.

For the purposes of optimal organization and scheduling of intentions, all Mass Intention Requests with the customary stipend should be submitted in writing to Canon Estrada.

From now on, a \$2 offering is suggested for those requesting a Mass Card. Because this offering for the Mass Card is not part of the Mass Stipend, please make a separate payment for this expense.
