As we strive to serve even better in the coming year, we are pleased to announce the following appointments approved by the Institute superiors:

Rev. Canon Aaron B. Huberfeld is appointed chaplain of the Society of the Sacred Heart, the lay society of the Institute, working in close cooperation with the Governor General of the Society in the United States, Dr. James P. Sutherland.
