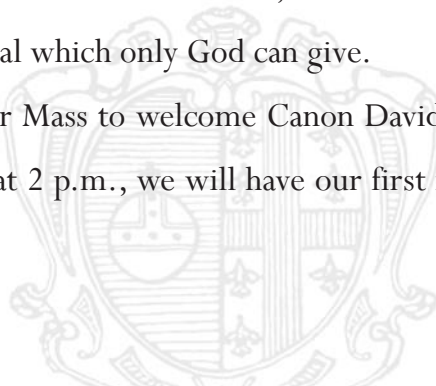


## FROM THE VICE RECTOR: CANON ANDREW TODD
