## FROM THE VICE RECTOR: CANON ANDREW TODD

Dear faithful of the Shrine,

This Thursday is the feast of Corpus Christi. A 7 PM Mass will be held in the Upper Room in addition to the 8 AM Mass in the house chapel.

Scaffolding has been removed and the concrete repairs to the decks and the beams has been completed! The limestone lintel on the south face of the tower was extremely compromised in the fire, leaving the structural integrity questionable. The lintel was removed and replaced with a concrete beam. The existing concrete beam below the lintel was also removed and replaced with concrete. Each level of the bell tower received concrete patching in areas where the fire damage was the greatest. Tuck-pointing and the brick pockets in preparation for the steel trusses is ongoing on the interior North wall. Once that work is finished, workers will move to the South side wall.
