This past week, workers proceeded to remove rows of damaged brick on the north and south walls above the altar area in the sanctuary of the church, and then proceeded to lay new brick. Mortar was also ground out between the existing bricks in view of their repair. Next week, new block and bond beam walls will be built at the wing walls on the west side of the gable.
