FROM THE VICE RECTOR: CANON JEAN-BAPTISTE COMMINS

Dear faithful of the Shrine,

It was only two years ago around this time I was here with you at the Shrine of the Infant King, celebrating my first mass and giving my first blessings. This was just before moving to Saint Louis to serve as a vicar, and only two days before the fire devastated our dear shrine. It is therefore not without emotion that I come to Chicago to serve and help our dear faithful during these difficult times for our Shrine of the Infant King.

To introduce myself briefly, I am the fourth child in a family of ten. Raised in a military family I was given the opportunity to live on four continents (Europe, Africa, South and North America) and to experience the richness of so many different cultures. I was blessed to grow up in a very catholic family and environment, as a teenager attending a minor seminary in France and also in New Hampshire, and later joining the Institute after spending three years in a prestigious Institute school near Paris.

I'm very thankful to God for the grace of spending a year in Africa as a seminarian, helping our dear Canon Stein. What a tremendous blessing for me to have learned through the generous example and dedication of the zealous Canons serving in Africa.

As a first request, I would humbly like to ask of your prayers for my vocation as well as that of my confreres. Ask the Sacred Heart, often or even daily, to make our hearts always more meek and humble! 'O Jesus meek and humble of heart, make our hearts like unto thine.

 UPDATE: PREPARING FOR NEW ROOF INSTALLATION



The parapet wall over the north vestibule is done. The CMU bond beam at the top was tied to the existing masonry wall with rebar to the sides and new stainless steel threaded rods were used in the center of the CMU to tie the block to the brick. The South wall will start next week.

Welcome to the Institute of Christ the King Sovereign Priest, an international religious community with over 90 apostolates worldwide whose aim is the defense and propagation of the reign of Christ in all areas of human life. The Shrine of Christ the King, Provincial Headquarters of the Institute and Chicago architectural landmark, has maintained its presence in the Woodlawn community since 2004, but sustained significant damage after a 3-alarm fire on October 7, 2015. Grateful to Cardinal Blase Cupich and the Archdiocese of Chicago for entrusting the Shrine's property ownership and restoration to our care and thankful to our neighbors at the First Presbyterian Church of Chicago, we are able to continue our weekend and evening traditional liturgies in Latin in the third floor Upper Room of their building (6400 S. Kimbark Ave). Morning weekday Masses are offered in the Priory chapel (6415 S. Woodlawn Ave), where St. Benedict's social hall is located on the lower level.

Throughout the year, extensive opportunities for spiritual growth accompany Shrine life through conferences, various devotions, and cultural events for all ages. Special importance and emphasis is given to the spiritual education and formation of our youth in their sacramental preparation taught by the priests.

We cordially invite you to join us for Mass, devotions, and our conferences to strengthen you on your spiritual journey. Plenty of non-permit street parking is available on S. Kimbark Avenue and E. 64th Street and a parking lot is available adjacent to the rectory. Please check our bulletin for mass times and upcoming events.
