## FROM THE VICE RECTOR: CANON JEAN-BAPTISTE COMMINS

Dear Faithful of the Shrine,

Saint Francis de Sales once wrote: 'And when children begin to use their reason, fathers and mothers should take great pains to fill their hearts with the fear of God. This the good Queen Blanche did most earnestly by St. Louis, her son: witness her oft-repeated words, "My son, I would sooner see you die than guilty of a mortal sin;" words which sank so deeply into the saintly monarch's heart, that he himself said there was no day on which they did not recur to his mind, and strengthen him in treading God's ways.'

I would rather die, in God's friendship, than grievously offend Him, knowing that the consequence of such an act would shut for me the Gates of Heaven for all eternity. What a great understanding of the reality of grace and sin. Necessity as well to confess venial sins because as we know, repeated venial sins lead the soul to a great peril, that of falling into a grave sin.

This is why, the canons here present make the sacrament of confession available at the Shrine one half hour daily before the celebration of Holy Mass. On Sundays, confessions are available as soon as 7:30am before the 8am mass, and as soon as 9am until the beginning of the 10am Mass.

In this same effort to make it possible for as many people as possible receive this Sacrament before the start of Mass, we kindly ask you not to hesitate to come as early as 7:30am or 9am on Sundays so as to take full advantage of the time imparted to us for this ministry.

UPDATE: PREPARING FOR NEW ROOF INSTALLATION



**Preparation for Roof Installation: Wall Rebuild**

Brick has been removed at the southwest corner of the building. Similar reconstruction to be done in this area as other parapets. New brick will build the wall back up. Then a bond beam will be installed on top to provide support to the wall.

As we commemorate the 2<sup>nd</sup> Anniversary of the 2015 fire at the Shrine on October 7th, we are now able to update you on our adjusted construction schedule:

- Steel shop drawings have been approved and the materials to build the steel are being procured
- Fabrication of the steel to begin middle of October
- Steel roof framing to start erection early to mid-November
- Roof installation beginning of the new year, January 2018
- Work will continue through the winter depending on good working conditions... prayers please!
- Critical Masonry work will continue throughout the steel setting process and finish up in February after the roof has been completed.

GETTING TO KNOW OUR COMMUNITY AT THE SHRINE OF CHRIST THE KING

Welcome to the Institute of Christ the King Sovereign Priest, an international religious community with over 90 apostolates worldwide whose aim is the defense and propagation of the reign of Christ in all areas of human life. The Shrine of Christ the King, Provincial Headquarters of the Institute and Chicago architectural landmark, has maintained its presence in the Woodlawn community since 2004, but sustained significant damage after a 3-alarm fire on October 7, 2015. Grateful to Cardinal Blase Cupich and the Archdiocese of Chicago for entrusting the Shrine's property ownership and restoration to our care and thankful to our neighbors at the First Presbyterian Church of Chicago, we are able to continue our weekend and evening traditional liturgies in Latin in the third floor Upper Room of their building (6400 S. Kimbark Ave). Morning weekday Masses are offered in the Priory chapel (6415 S. Woodlawn Ave), where St. Benedict's social hall is located on the lower level.
