FROM THE VICE RECTOR: CANON JEAN-BAPTISTE COMMINS

Dear faithful of the Shrine,

Next Sunday, we will celebrate the feast of Our Lord Jesus Christ, King of Heaven and Earth. One week now to prepare ourselves and our homes to welcome the King of kings. What kind of welcome are we going to give Him? To help you to meditate on the Royalty of Our Lord this week, I will simply give you this powerful quote from Pope Pius XI in his encyclical *Quas Primas*, he says:

It has long been a common custom to give to Christ the metaphorical title of "King," because of the high degree of perfection whereby he excels all creatures. So he is said to reign "in the hearts of men," both by reason of the keenness of his intellect and the extent of his knowledge, and also because he is very truth, and it is from him that truth must be obediently received by all mankind. He reigns, too, in the wills of men, for in him the human will was perfectly and entirely obedient to the Holy Will of God, and further by his grace and inspiration he so subjects our free-will as to incite us to the most noble endeavors. He is King of hearts, too, by reason of his "charity which exceeds all knowledge." And his mercy and kindness which draw all men to him, for never has it been known, nor will it ever be, that man be loved so much and so universally as Jesus Christ.

Let us prepare ourselves for this feast of Christ the King, purifying our intelligence and will power from all that impedes Our King to truly reigns in us, in our families, and in our society.

RESURRECTION FROM ASHES CAMPAIGN

UPDATE: IMPORTANT PRESS RELEASE !

The **National Fund for Sacred Places**, a program of Partners for Sacred Places and the National Trust for Historic Preservation, announced the acceptance of **Shrine of Christ the King** as one of 17 congregations nationwide to participate in a national grant-making program that supports capital building projects at historic houses of worship. Launched last year with grants totaling \$14 million from the Indiana-based Lilly Endowment Inc., the National Fund will offer planning grants, professional services, and capital grants ranging from \$50,000 to \$250,000 to a minimum of 50 congregations over four years.

Chad Martin, Director of the National Fund, says that Shrine of Christ the King was well positioned for acceptance into this year's cohort, for which over 220 congregations applied. *"We are thrilled with the opportunity to be a part of this major preservation effort, a project to save a building rooted deeply in historic Catholic architecture. The story of the Shrine re-enlivening this sacred place as an asset for the community, and persevering despite two major fires in recent years is important for Chicago and for the country."* (For rest of the text, visit: <http://shrinelandmark.org/>)

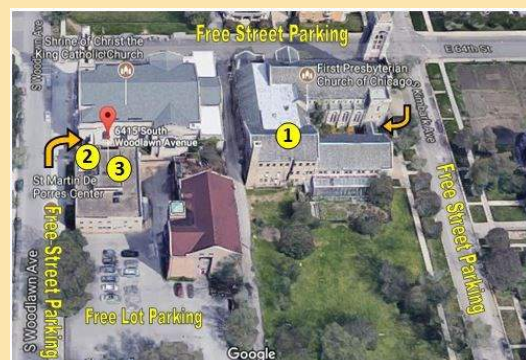
GETTING TO KNOW OUR COMMUNITY AT THE SHRINE OF CHRIST THE KING

Welcome to the Institute of Christ the King Sovereign Priest, an international religious community with over 90 apostolates worldwide whose aim is the defense and propagation of the reign of Christ in all areas of human life. The Shrine of Christ the King, Provincial Headquarters of the Institute and Chicago architectural landmark, has maintained its presence in the Woodlawn community since 2004, but sustained significant damage after a 3-alarm fire on October 7, 2015. Grateful to Cardinal Blase Cupich and the Archdiocese of Chicago for entrusting the Shrine's property ownership and restoration to our care and thankful to our neighbors at the First Presbyterian Church of Chicago, we are able to continue our weekend and evening traditional liturgies in Latin in the third floor Upper Room of their building (6400 S. Kimbark Ave). Morning weekday Masses are offered in the Priory chapel (6415 S. Woodlawn Ave), where St. Benedict's social hall is located on the lower level.

Throughout the year, extensive opportunities for spiritual growth accompany Shrine life through conferences, various devotions, and cultural events for all ages. Special importance and emphasis is given to the spiritual education and formation of our youth in their sacramental preparation taught by the priests.

We cordially invite you to join us for Mass, devotions, and our conferences to strengthen you on your spiritual journey. Plenty of non-permit street parking is available on S. Kimbark Avenue and E. 64th Street and a parking lot is available adjacent to the rectory. Please check our bulletin for mass times and upcoming events.
