

From the Vice Rector: Canon Jean-Baptiste Commins

Dear faithful of the Shrine,

O Lord, the portion of my inheritance and my chalice, You are He who will restore my inheritance.

This is the prayer that has to be recited every time one vests himself with the cassock. In these few words from the Psalm 15 is resumed the life of the one who wants to consecrate himself entirely to God.

First, Our Lord Jesus Christ is our inheritance, more than a simple treasure we would have received, the whole divinity wants to take possession of the priest, *Alter Christus*, another Christ, and then of anyone willing to give himself to the vineyard of the Lord, in accordance with his proper vocation. We therefore partake in the riches of the merits Christ acquired on the cross for us, this is how our inheritance was restored despite our sins, original and actual. This vestment, the cassock, should remind us of that dual relation, donation-reception. We give ourselves to God, and in return he gives himself to us and vice-versa.

Second, the Lord is my chalice, this precious chalice which represents a life of complete dedication to souls, that is, a life of sacrifice, penance, and self-resignation. The chalice in which Christ himself poured his own blood, drop after drop for our salvation. What a grace to be able to unite, to conform ourselves to Christ through the vocation we have been called to.

Let us unite our prayers for Raymond, and beg the Divine Infant King the grace of perseverance for him and for all young man and women who have heard the call of their Master and have followed it, especially as members of the Institute.

Resurrection from Ashes Campaign Update:

Demolition of the Organ Loft was done last week to provide more access for the installation of the steel.

The existing loft construction was severely damaged in the fire and after being open to the elements for two year was unsafe and had to be removed.

No worries, the entire area was digitally scanned last year so it can be reconstructed to be better than new.

The use of Genie Lift is now on site helping the workers reach those high areas. Scaffolding will still be used at the far east and west walls and the lift will be able to reach almost everything else. Scaffolding has been installed on the far east wall for tuck-pointing.

Welcome to the Institute of Christ the King Sovereign Priest, an international religious community with over 90 apostolates worldwide whose aim is the defense and propagation of the reign of Christ in all areas of human life. The Shrine of Christ the King, Provincial Headquarters of the Institute and Chicago architectural landmark, has maintained its presence in the Woodlawn community since 2004, but sustained significant damage after a 3-alarm fire on October 7, 2015. Grateful to Cardinal Blase Cupich and the Archdiocese of Chicago for entrusting the Shrine's property ownership and restoration to our care and thankful to our neighbors at the First Presbyterian Church of Chicago, we are able to continue our weekend and evening traditional liturgies in Latin in the third floor Upper Room of their building (6400 S. Kimbark Ave). Morning weekday Masses are offered in the Priory chapel (6415 S. Woodlawn Ave), where St. Benedict's social hall is located on the lower level.

Throughout the year, extensive opportunities for spiritual growth accompany Shrine life through conferences, various devotions, and cultural events for all ages. Special importance and emphasis is given to the spiritual education and formation of our youth in their sacramental preparation taught by the priests.

We cordially invite you to join us for Mass, devotions, and our conferences to strengthen you on your spiritual journey. Plenty of non-permit street parking is available on S. Kimbark Avenue and E. 64th Street and a parking lot is available adjacent to the rectory. Please check our bulletin for mass times and upcoming events.
