FROM THE VICE RECTOR: CANON JEAN-BAPTISTE COMMINS

Dear faithful of the Shrine,

The month of November having just begun, it is important to remind ourselves of the possibility the Church gives us to gain indulgences for us or for the souls of our beloved deceased by way of suffrage (these souls not being able any longer to merit, can only receive help from us on earth and through our prayers and sacrifices).

An indulgence is the remission before God of the temporal punishment due for sins already forgiven as far as their guilt is concerned. This remission the faithful with the proper dispositions and under certain determined conditions acquire through the intervention of the Church which, as minister of the Redemption, authoritatively dispenses and applies the treasury of the satisfaction won by Christ and the Saints.

To acquire a plenary indulgence it is necessary to perform the work to which the indulgence is attached and to fulfill the following three conditions: sacramental confession, Eucharistic Communion, and prayer for the intention of the Sovereign Pontiff within a few days before or after the indulgenced act. It is further required that all attachment to sin, even venial sin, be absent.

Particularly for the month of November:

An indulgence, applicable only to the Souls in Purgatory, is granted to the faithful, who devoutly visit a cemetery and pray, for the departed.

The indulgence is plenary each day from the 1st to the 8th of November; on other days of the year it is partial.

RESURRECTION FROM ASHES CAMPAIGN. UPDATE:



The use of Genie Lift is now on site helping the workers reach those high areas. Scaffolding will still be used at the far east and west walls and the lift will be able to reach almost everything else. Scaffolding has been installed on the far east wall for tuck-pointing.

(Tuck-pointing is the method of repairing weathered joints in old masonry. The joints are cut or raked and then wet mortar is place in the joint.)

Welcome to the Institute of Christ the King Sovereign Priest, an international religious community with over 90 apostolates worldwide whose aim is the defense and propagation of the reign of Christ in all areas of human life. The Shrine of Christ the King, Provincial Headquarters of the Institute and Chicago architectural landmark, has maintained its presence in the Woodlawn community since 2004, but sustained significant damage after a 3-alarm fire on October 7, 2015. Grateful to Cardinal Blase Cupich and the Archdiocese of Chicago for entrusting the Shrine's property ownership and restoration to our care and thankful to our neighbors at the First Presbyterian Church of Chicago, we are able to continue our weekend and evening traditional liturgies in Latin in the third floor Upper Room of their building (6400 S. Kimbark Ave). Morning weekday Masses are offered in the Priory chapel (6415 S. Woodlawn Ave), where St. Benedict's social hall is located on the lower level.

Throughout the year, extensive opportunities for spiritual growth accompany Shrine life through conferences, various devotions, and cultural events for all ages. Special importance and emphasis is given to the spiritual education and formation of our youth in their sacramental preparation taught by the priests.

We cordially invite you to join us for Mass, devotions, and our conferences to strengthen you on your spiritual journey. Plenty of non-permit street parking is available on S. Kimbark Avenue and E. 64th Street and a parking lot is available adjacent to the rectory. Please check our bulletin for mass times and upcoming events.
