FROM THE VICE-RECTOR: CANON JEAN-BAPTISTE COMMINS

Dear faithful,

**Epiphany**; meaning “manifestation”. The three manifestations offered by the Church in its liturgy to reveal, to affirm and to confirm that Christ is the King, is the Son of God, and is the Redeemer.

January 6th; God reveals His beloved Son to mankind through the Magi, the three kings.

On the feast of the Commemoration of the Baptism of Our Lord, God the Father confirms, that Christ is truly his beloved Son: “*And I saw, and I gave testimony, that this is the Son of God*”.

And finally, on the II Sunday after the Epiphany, the liturgy reminds us of the first miracle of Our Lord performed at the wedding feast at Cana. “*Do whatever he tells you.*” This precious wine as a prefiguration, as an announcement that soon that same wine will become His own Precious Blood.

On these blessed days, let us ask for an increase of that same faith that guided the Magi on their journey, of that same hope that confirmed St John in his predication, and of that same love that enflamed the hearts of the guests at Cana.

## RESURRECTION FROM ASHES CAMPAIGN

Here is an update for the work done in December 2017 at the Shrine

### Phase I

- \* East Pediment masonry wall tuck-pointed
- \* Purlins removed from the West and Interior East Pediment Walls
- \* Scaffolding installed at the west wall above the choir loft
- \* Demolition of masonry at interior face of West Pediment Wall
- \* Warming rooms created for winter conditions
- \* Temporary electrical has been set up
- \* 12/15 WJE site visit to steel fabrication shop to inspect Truss No 1
- \* Truss No 2 & 3 in fabrication
- \* Miscellaneous plates and bent angles have been fabricated



### Phase II

- \* Request for Proposals for HVAC Performance Specification and for Engineering went out to a fourth engineering firm

Welcome to the Institute of Christ the King Sovereign Priest, an international religious community with over 90 apostolates worldwide whose aim is the defense and propagation of the reign of Christ in all areas of human life. The Shrine of Christ the King, Provincial Headquarters of the Institute and Chicago architectural landmark, has maintained its presence in the Woodlawn community since 2004, but sustained significant damage after a 3-alarm fire on October 7, 2015. Grateful to Cardinal Blase Cupich and the Archdiocese of Chicago for entrusting the Shrine's property ownership and restoration to our care and thankful to our neighbors at the First Presbyterian Church of Chicago, we are able to continue our weekend and evening traditional liturgies in Latin in the third floor Upper Room of their building (6400 S. Kimbark Ave). Morning weekday Masses are offered in the Priory chapel (6415 S. Woodlawn Ave), where St. Benedict's social hall is located on the lower level.

We cordially invite you to join us for Mass, devotions, and our conferences to strengthen you on your spiritual journey. Plenty of non-permit street parking is available on S. Kimbark Avenue and E. 64th Street and a parking lot is available adjacent to the rectory. Please check our bulletin for mass times and upcoming events.
