FROM THE VICE-RECTOR: CANON JEAN-BAPTISTE COMMINS

Dear faithful, please join us in our Private Novena Prayer to Our Lord Eternal Priest as we approach the priestly ordination, on January 31, of Deacon Joseph Heppelle from Canada.

RESURRECTION FROM ASHES CAMPAIGN: RESTORATION UPDATE



Due to the very cold temperatures, masonry work could not continue this past week. However, more brick and materials have arrived, and winterized scaffolding is now completely in place to continue work on the west elevation (above choir loft) once temperatures become a little warmer. The steel trusses continue to be fabricated at the Southside workshop. Truss No 1, 2 & 3 are done. Truss No 5 (photo at left) is being laid out and will be inspected by the engineers next week. By the end of next week half of the eight trusses will be fabricated. Due to the large size

of the trusses, maneuvering them for the work in the shop is itself a time-consuming process. Angles/channels for purlins are being cut as well. Purlins are roof framing steel beams that span perpendicular to the trusses. Date of delivery still to be determined.

GETTING TO KNOW OUR COMMUNITY AT THE SHRINE OF CHRIST THE KING

Welcome to the Institute of Christ the King Sovereign Priest, an international religious community with over 90 apostolates worldwide whose aim is the defense and propagation of the reign of Christ in all areas of human life. The Shrine of Christ the King, Provincial Headquarters of the Institute and Chicago architectural landmark, has maintained its presence in the Woodlawn community since 2004, but sustained significant damage after a 3-alarm fire on October 7, 2015. Grateful to Cardinal Blase Cupich and the Archdiocese of Chicago for entrusting the Shrine's property ownership and restoration to our care and thankful to our neighbors at the First Presbyterian Church of Chicago, we are able to continue our weekend and evening traditional liturgies in Latin in the third floor Upper Room of their building (6400 S. Kimbark Ave). Morning weekday Masses are offered in the Priory chapel (6415 S. Woodlawn Ave), where St. Benedict's social hall is located on the lower level. Plenty of non-permit street parking is available on S. Kimbark Avenue and E. 64th Street and a parking lot is available adjacent to the rectory.
