## FROM THE VICE-RECTOR: CANON JEAN-BAPTISTE COMMINS

Dear faithful, mark your calendar!

- This coming Saturday is our Annual Benefit Dinner, many tickets still available for you, your family and your friends! This Dinner has a big success every year. It comes to be a great opportunity to fundraise for the Shrine especially since we are approaching the end of the first phase and the beginning of the second phase of our Restoration Project.

- Next Sunday, we will be discussing some interesting issues such as the Buddhist and Taoist fundaments, the main ideas of the "New Age" as an Eastern Formula in Western Terms, and the Alternative Medicines in the Western Civilization under the light of the Church teaching and Thomistic theology. **Abstinence:** On the Fridays outside of Lent the U.S. bishops conference obtained the permission of the Holy See for Catholics in the US to substitute a penitential, or even a charitable, practice of their own choosing. For most people the easiest practice to consistently fulfill will be the traditional one, to abstain from meat on all Fridays of the year. During Lent abstinence from meat on Fridays is obligatory in the United States as elsewhere.

## GETTING TO KNOW OUR COMMUNITY AT THE SHRINE OF CHRIST THE KING

Welcome to the Institute of Christ the King Sovereign Priest, an international religious community with over 90 apostolates worldwide whose aim is the defense and propagation of the reign of Christ in all areas of human life. The Shrine of Christ the King, Provincial Headquarters of the Institute and Chicago architectural landmark, has maintained its presence in the Woodlawn community since 2004, but sustained significant damage after a 3-alarm fire on October 7, 2015. All Masses are offered in the St. Joseph Crypt Chapel (6415 S. Woodlawn Ave), where St. Benedict's social hall is located on the lower level of the Priory. A parking lot is available adjacent to the rectory.

*To access St. Joseph Crypt Chapel:*

- Use the back entrance (next to our garage), from the parking lot (no stairs).
- Use the usual gate and staircase, accessible from Woodlawn Ave.
