FROM THE VICE-RECTOR: CANON JEAN-BAPTISTE COMMINS

Dear faithful,

This coming Sunday, March 18, we are hosting a special coffee social in honor of St. Joseph. The custom originated in Italy where there was a famine in the Middle Ages. The people prayed to St. Joseph and asked for his intercession. Their prayers were answered and the famine ended. A special feast of thanksgiving was held in commemoration of the saint and the celebration has become a tradition.

A typical St. Joseph's Table will have a statue of him surrounded by flowers and candles, figures and symbols of his life, and specially prepared cakes, breads, and cookies as well as other meatless dishes. It is customary to extend this invitation to neighbors, family and friends. Offerings of food are appreciated along with donations benefiting the House of Hope.

Abstinence: On the Fridays outside of Lent the U.S. bishops conference obtained the permission of the Holy See for Catholics in the US to substitute a penitential, or even a charitable, practice of their own choosing. They must do some penitential/charitable practice on these Fridays. For most people the easiest practice to consistently fulfill will be the traditional one, to abstain from meat on all Fridays of the year. During Lent abstinence from meat on Fridays is obligatory in the United States as elsewhere.

RESURRECTION FROM ASHES CAMPAIGN: RESTORATION UPDATE



On March 9, Wiss, Janney, Elstner Associates (WJE), Ibarra Group were on site to perform the Skidmore Wilhelm test, bolt testing. This test is the pre-installation verification tension testing to measure fastener performance. General fastener testing is done to determine torque/tension relationships and is tested on bolts, lock nuts and direct tension indicating washers.

GETTING TO KNOW OUR COMMUNITY AT THE SHRINE OF CHRIST THE KING

Welcome to the Institute of Christ the King Sovereign Priest, an international religious community with over 90 apostolates worldwide whose aim is the defense and propagation of the reign of Christ in all areas of human life. The Shrine of Christ the King, Provincial Headquarters of the Institute and Chicago architectural landmark, has maintained its presence in the Woodlawn community since 2004, but sustained significant damage after a 3-alarm fire on October 7, 2015. All Masses are offered in the St. Joseph Crypt Chapel (6415 S. Woodlawn Ave), where St. Benedict's social hall is located on the lower level of the Priory. A parking lot is available adjacent to the rectory.

To access St. Joseph Crypt Chapel:

- Use the back entrance (next to our garage), from the parking lot (no stairs).
- Use the usual gate and staircase, accessible from Woodlawn Ave.
