

RESURRECTION FROM ASHES CAMPAIGN: RESTORATION UPDATE



Truss 1 was removed this past week! With all the steel purlins removed from Truss 1 to the west wall and between Truss 1 & Truss 2, the truss was prepped for removal. A large crane staged on 64th Street held the truss in tension with the use of a spreader rod that was attached in two places to the truss. Iron workers released the steel on the south side first and attached a tether to

hold it in place. Then the steel on the north side was released, allowing for the crane to lift the truss up over the north parapet wall and lay it on the ground. Success! The first truss is out, now starts the prep work for installing the new truss!

Welcome to the Institute of Christ the King Sovereign Priest, an international religious community with over 90 apostolates worldwide whose aim is the defense and propagation of the reign of Christ in all areas of human life. The Shrine of Christ the King, Provincial Headquarters of the Institute and Chicago architectural landmark, has maintained its presence in the Woodlawn community since 2004, but sustained significant damage after a 3-alarm fire on October 7, 2015. All Masses are offered in the St. Joseph Crypt Chapel (6415 S. Woodlawn Ave), where St. Benedict's social hall is located on the lower level of the Priory. A parking lot is available adjacent to the rectory.

To access St. Joseph Crypt Chapel:

- Back entrance behind the Priory from the parking lot, down the ramp.
- Gate and staircase, accessible from Woodlawn Ave. Between Church & Priory

Abstinence: On the Fridays outside of Lent the U.S. bishops conference obtained the permission of the Holy See for Catholics in the US to substitute a penitential, or even a charitable, practice of their own choosing. They must do some penitential/charitable practice on these Fridays. For most people the easiest practice to consistently fulfill will be the traditional one, to abstain from meat on all Fridays of the year. During Lent abstinence from meat on Fridays is obligatory in the United States as elsewhere.

Canon 1251 CIC: Abstinence and fast are to be observed on Ash Wednesday and on the **Friday of the Passion and Death of Our Lord Jesus Christ.**
