TRUSS INSTALLATION COMPLETION!

April has been a very busy month at the Shrine, and the weather may finally be conducive to even more high quality work!

For the roofing diaphragm, most steel purlins are installed, while half of sag rods are installed. This week masonry work was done to repair the east pediment wall (photo) 70 feet up so that the purlins can be installed there early next week.



The plates which connect the trusses to the vertical steel columns will be welded this week. After weld inspection, brick will be laid around these plates. Valley beams are in fabrication. Wood framing and sheathing at the altar are complete and roofing in this area has begun. Metal decking is due for delivery this week.



With 2 lifts and a lull, plus scaffolding, Work space in the church is tight but moving ahead as quickly as possible!

GETTING TO KNOW OUR COMMUNITY AT THE SHRINE OF CHRIST THE KING

Welcome to the Institute of Christ the King Sovereign Priest, an international religious community with over 90 apostolates worldwide whose aim is the defense and propagation of the reign of Christ in all areas of human life. The Shrine of Christ the King, Provincial Headquarters of the Institute and Chicago architectural landmark, has maintained its presence in the Woodlawn community since 2004, but sustained significant damage after a 3-alarm fire on October 7, 2015. All Masses are offered in the St. Joseph Crypt Chapel (6415 S. Woodlawn Ave), where St. Benedict's social hall is located on the lower level of the Priory. A parking lot is available adjacent to the rectory.

To access St. Joseph Crypt Chapel:

- Back entrance behind the Priory from the parking lot, down the ramp.
- Gate and staircase, accessible from Woodlawn Ave. Between Church & Priory
