RESURRECTION FROM ASHES CAMPAIGN: RESTORATION UPDATE



UNIQUE OPPORTUNITY TO COMPLETE PHASE 1 FUNDRAISING

In early October, 2017, the National Fund for Sacred Places announced that the Shrine was invited to be a grant recipient: [Press Release & National Fund Collateral Document](#).

All capital grants awarded from the National Fund for Sacred Places require a cash match. Since the Shrine had made a request for \$250,000 in order to help finance the new roof system project, it sought out to raise 2:1 matching funds in the amount of \$500,000 in pledges, cash gifts, or in other ways described on the printed informational materials. Thus, because of the grant, every \$1 that was donated and given to the restoration fund between October 1, 2017 and April 1, 2018, became \$1.50.

We are thrilled to announce that the goal of raising \$500,000 in pledges or cash by Easter Sunday, April 1, 2018, in order to receive the \$250,000 grant from the National Fund was reached!

\$561,441 RAISED OF \$500,000 GOAL

The \$250,000 grant money will be received this Summer upon completion of the roof construction. The combined \$750,000 (\$500,000 raised in cash and pledges + \$250,000 grant) will bring us to our \$3,000,000 for Phase 1.

GETTING TO KNOW OUR COMMUNITY AT THE SHRINE OF CHRIST THE KING

Welcome to the Institute of Christ the King Sovereign Priest, an international religious community with over 90 apostolates worldwide whose aim is the defense and propagation of the reign of Christ in all areas of human life. The Shrine of Christ the King, Provincial Headquarters of the Institute and Chicago architectural landmark, has maintained its presence in the Woodlawn community since 2004, but sustained significant damage after a 3-alarm fire on October 7, 2015. All Masses are offered in the St. Joseph Crypt Chapel (6415 S. Woodlawn Ave), where St. Benedict's social hall is located on the lower level of the Priory. A parking lot is available adjacent to the rectory.

To access St. Joseph Crypt Chapel:

- **Back entrance behind the Priory from the parking lot, down the ramp.**
- **Gate and staircase, accessible from Woodlawn Ave. Between Church & Priory**
