FROM THE VICE-RECTOR: CANON JEAN-BAPTISTE COMMINS

Dear Faithful,

Why some confusion in the texts of the liturgy of these last Sundays after Pentecost?

The Gregorian Antiphony which contains the music to be sung at Mass during the year, (attributed to Pope Gregory I) has only 24 Sundays after Pentecost. However, the length of the period **after Pentecost** varies depending on the day of Easter every year. Which causes some of the Sundays **after the Epiphany** to be omitted.

Therefore these texts omitted after the Epiphany are now used for the "extra" Sundays after Pentecost. For instance:

- If 25 Sundays: then for the 24th, prayers and readings of the 6th Sunday after the Epiphany.
- If 26 Sundays: then for the 24th, prayers and readings of the 5th Sunday after the Epiphany.
- If 27 Sundays: then for the 24th, prayers and readings of the 4th Sunday after the Epiphany. And so on...

For 2018, we have 27 Sundays after Pentecost, therefore for the 24th Sunday we use the prayers and readings of the 4th Sunday after the Epiphany! Makes sense!
