

HISTORY OF THE DEVOTION TO THE INFANT JESUS: PART I

Christians always longed to show their deep reverence to the incarnate Word of God, Jesus Christ. The Child Jesus was adored by Church Fathers like St. Athanasius and St. Jerome. St. Jerome was attracted by the mysteries of the birth and childhood of Jesus. He even went to dwell in Bethlehem living near the cave, which Christians believed to have been the birth place of the Divine Child. Other great devotees of the Infant Jesus: St. Bernard of Clairvaux, St. Francis of Assisi and St. Anthony of Padua. St. Francis of Assisi considered the birthday of the Infant Jesus as the feast of feasts because the Son of God lowered himself to become a poor child. It is St. Francis of Assisi who is said to have prepared the first crib for the Christmas of 1226. In the 16th century, St. Teresa of Avila, who always traveled with her sculpture of the Infant Jesus as she founded new convents, cultivated devotion to the Infant Jesus.

In the 17th century when Protestants and Catholics were fighting one another furiously the Protestant army besieged the city of Prague in Central Europe. Owing to which the reigning Catholic King Fredrick II sought the help of Pope Paul V. The Pope deputed Ven. Fr. Dominic, the Superior General of the Order of Discalced Carmelites who had great devotion to the Virgin Mary to assist the frightened troops. The Protestant army was defeated and the victory was attributed to the fervent prayers of Fr. Dominic. Hence as a token of gratitude the King built three monasteries for the Carmelites. They were also given the Church of the Holy Trinity that had belonged to the Protestants. The Carmelites changed its name to that of Our Lady of Victory in remembrance of the victory gained in the war. In His great Divine plan God deigned that this church should be the cradle of devotion to the Infant Jesus.
