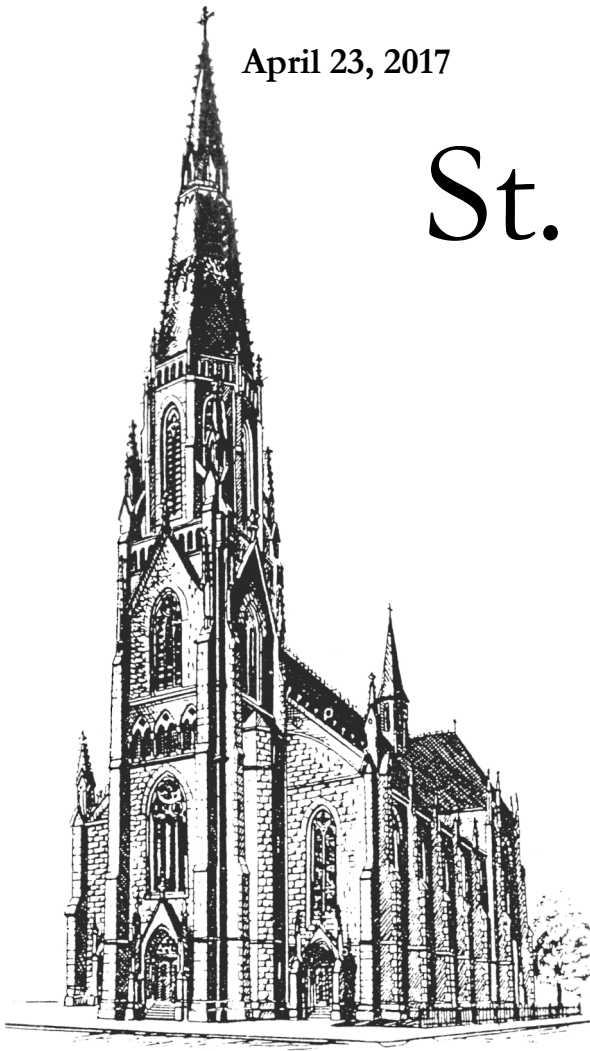
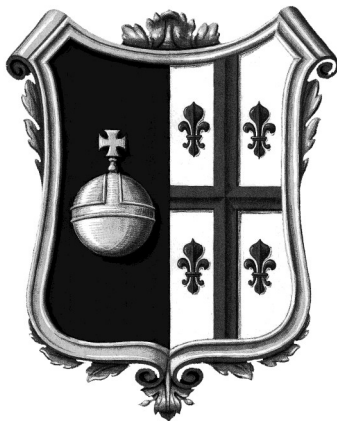


FROM THE RECTOR: CANON MICHAEL STEIN
