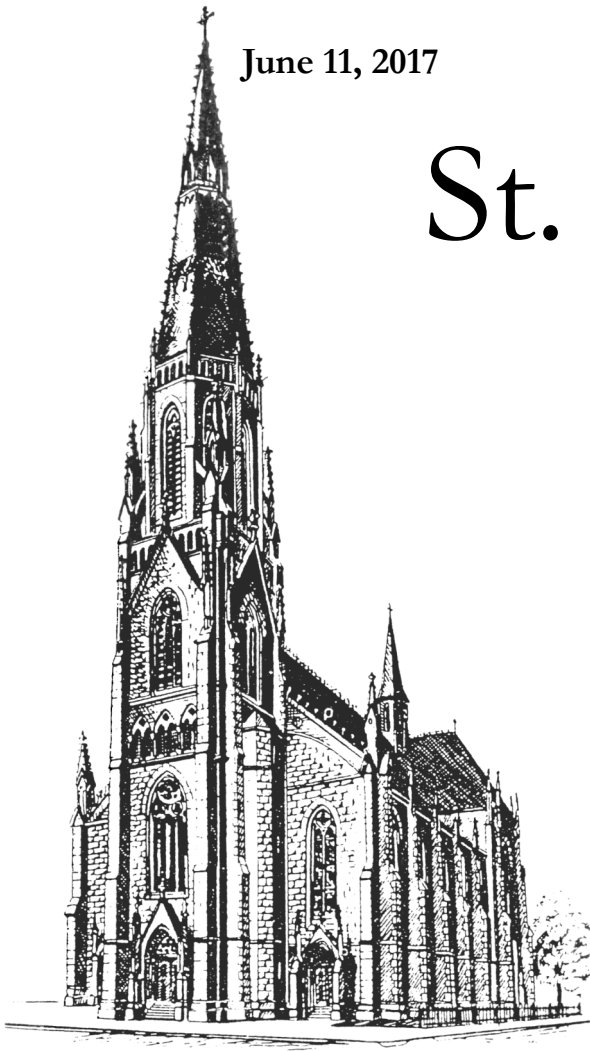

- Banner Bearers then 1st Communicants
- Choir and Schola
- All the Faithful
