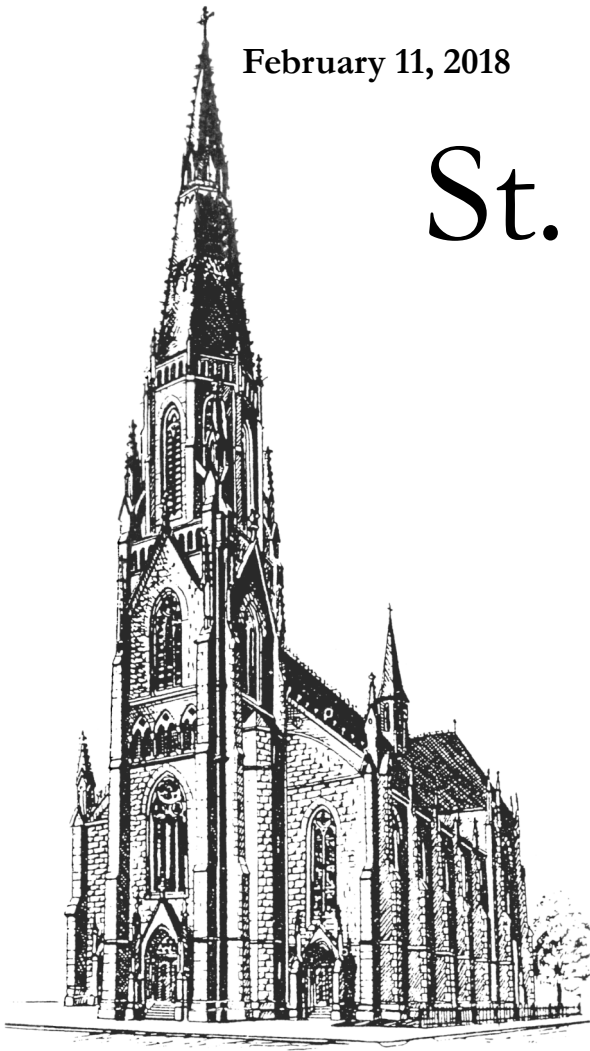



Lenten Rules concerning Fasting & Abstinence:

***Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are obligatory days of fasting and abstinence for Catholics. In addition, Fridays during Lent are obligatory days of abstinence.***

***For members of the Latin Catholic Church, the norms on fasting are obligatory from age 18 - 59. When fasting, a person is permitted to eat one full meal, as well as two smaller meals that together are not equal to a full meal. The norms concerning abstinence from meat are binding upon members of the Latin Catholic Church from age 14 onwards.***
