## The Resurrection of Our Lord

*Haec dies, quam fecit Dominus: exultemus, et litmus in ea.*

On this day, Christ our Passover was sacrificed, for He is the true Lamb who took away the sins of the world, who by His death destroyed our death, and by His Resurrection restored our life. Easter means Redemption obtained; sin destroyed, death overcome, divine life brought back to us, and the resurrection of our body which is promised immortality.

Christ, our Paschal Lamb at the time of His passion was sacrificed once and for all; this is the Christian Passover which is never ending. The lesson is to exclude from our lives the "old leaven," that is sin and our evil tendencies, and put in its place "the unleavened bread of sincerity and truth." If we have risen with Christ our life should be entirely changed.

*Pascha nostrum immolatus est Christus, Alleluia!*

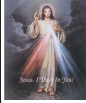

### Good Friday - Divine Mercy Sunday

Jesus asked that the Feast of the Divine Mercy be preceded by a Novena to the Divine Mercy which begins on **Good Friday**. He gave St. Faustina an intention to pray for on each day of the Novena, saving for the last day the most difficult intention of all, the lukewarm and indifferent. Jesus told her; The last hope of salvation for them is to flee to My Mercy."

*In her diary, St. Faustina wrote that Jesus told her:*

"On each day of the novena you will bring to My heart a different group of souls and you will immerse them in this ocean of My mercy ... On each day you will beg My Father, on the strength of My passion, for the graces for these souls."
