Blessed is the King who comes...

"Just as the Lord entered the Holy City that day on a donkey," said Benedict XVI, "so too the Church saw him coming again and again in the humble form of bread and wine."

Therefore the scene of Palm Sunday is repeated in some way in our own life.

Jesus comes to the city of our soul in the humble guise of ordinary life: in the simplicity of the sacraments; or in gentle suggestions, like these: Fulfill your duty punctually; smile at whoever needs cheering up, even though there is sorrow in your soul; devote the necessary time to prayer, without haggling; go to the help of anyone who looks for you; practice justice and go beyond it with the grace of charity; forgive and/or ask for forgiveness.

We can also consider the significance of the donkey in this scene: There are hundreds of animals more beautiful, more deft and strong. But it was a donkey Christ chose when He presented Himself to the people as king in response to their acclamation.


For Jesus has no time for calculations, for astuteness, for the cruelty of cold hearts, for attractive but empty beauty. What He likes is the cheerfulness of a young heart, a simple step, a natural voice, clear eyes, attention to His affectionate word of advice. That is how He reigns in the soul.

Whoever welcomes Jesus with humility and simplicity can bring Him everywhere.

Have a beautiful Holy Week! Take courage.

Dear Friends,

I hope this message will find you well.

I would like my words to encourage you to attentively read our church's schedule for Holy Week. Yes we are living in difficult times but...as I told you previously this is a trying time, but it is also an opportunity. It is an opportunity to examine our lives, our consciences, and our priorities. It should be an opportunity to be more aware about the mysteries celebrated from Palm Sunday to Easter.

We must be thankful that here, in the Diocese of Green Bay, it is still possible to receive the Sacrament of Penance. I will be available for you. I will be traveling to Wausau to attend all the liturgies of Holy Week that will be solemnly celebrated at St. Mary's Oratory in Wausau.

We know that the celebration of the Sacred Liturgy, even when the faithful cannot be present, always attains its twofold end: the glory of God, and the sanctification of souls. **All of these ceremonies will be live-streamed:** you will find them on the homepage; <https://www.institute-christ-king.org/wausau-home> or on the Facebook page of St. Mary's in Wausau. <https://www.facebook.com/stmarysorarywausau/>

You may be wondering about the times for the ceremonies -- yes, the Triduum Masses are at 10:00am, and not in the afternoon or evening as you are accustomed to. The immediate reason for this is that it allows me to take part in liturgy so we can have Solemn Masses in Wausau. These times are by no means an innovation, however--the Church celebrated Holy Week in this way for well over a thousand years before the reforms of the 1950's.

Dear Friends, Jesus' Passion is a victory. Jesus is the Lamb sacrificed to God for the sins of the people. He accepts being the victim, but He is also the addressee and the priest. And the value of His Passion is our salvation. It is less about suffering than about the divine love Jesus put into His suffering that burns away original sin and all our individual sins. Jesus is victorious and masters everything. He triumphs over everything. And the only crown He accepts is the crown of thorns. Jesus is hidden but He is with all of our families.

St Patrick's remains your home and we are together!

Let us pray for each other, for the sick and the dying.

Let us take care of each other: All together, but everyone at home.

God bless and keep you all this Holy Week. I place you all on the paten, in the chalice, at the foot of the Cross.
