### My Lord and My God

Be sure that you understand that faith is not simply an act of the human intellect. God reaches out with what we call "prevenient grace," to prepare our minds to accept His truth. But man always retains his free will, and a person who is too highly attached to the things of the world may well push this grace aside—particularly if he sees unwelcome responsibilities and onerous duties associated with profession of the Catholic Faith. But it is precisely, as Saint John says, "our Faith which overcomes the world."

Faith is *not* a guarantee that things will always go well for us. It is *not* a matter of faith that we will always be successful in our endeavors; and *not* a matter of faith that we will always be free from hunger and thirst and sickness.

We do know by Faith that "God will not tempt us beyond our strength, but with the temptation will always give us a way out." The point is that by holding fast to what God has revealed about Himself, and what He wants of us, we will be rewarded with nothing less than the direct perpetual vision of God Himself. To the degree that such a thing is possible, the creature will possess the Creator in eternity.

Those who believe; those who reach out and accept God's gift of grace, will believe everything He has revealed on His authority alone. By their belief they will know God and come to love Him. This Faith and this Charity give us Hope, the virtue by which we prudently expect the rewards of Heaven as we overcome and go beyond the things of the world.

The Month of April is traditionally dedicated to devotion to Jesus in the sacrament of the Holy Eucharist. The Catholic Church teaches that the Blessed Sacrament is the real and living presence of Christ—His Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity—received into our souls with every reception of Holy Communion. Our Eucharistic Lord is the source and summit of our Christian life, the ultimate proof of His infinite love for us. Since we cannot now receive Him Sacramentally, let us desire to receive Him Spiritually into our hearts.

## Act of Spiritual Communion

My Jesus, I believe that Thou art present in the Blessed Sacrament.

I love Thee above all things and I desire Thee in my soul.

Since I cannot now receive Thee sacramentally, come at least spiritually into my heart. As though Thou wert already there, I embrace Thee and unite myself wholly to Thee; permit not that I should ever be separated from Thee. Amen.

## The Feast Of Divine Mercy

From ancient times the Easter octave, culminating on the 8th day, has been centered on the theme of God's mercy and forgiveness. The final day of the octave celebration of Easter is meant to be a day of thanksgiving to God for his goodness to mankind through the Paschal mystery, that is, the Passion, death, and Resurrection of our Savior Jesus Christ. The Second Sunday of Easter was named Divine Mercy Sunday by Pope St. John Paul II following a request from Our Lord in his private revelations to St. Faustina Kowalska. On this day Jesus promised to open the floodgates of his inexhaustible mercy and shower abundant graces on those who participate in this feast day.

Normally, a **plenary indulgence** is granted under the usual conditions, but **because of the pandemic**, anyone who, with “**the will to fulfill the usual conditions** (sacramental

confession, Eucharistic communion and prayer according to the Holy Father's intentions), as soon as possible,” recites the **Divine Mercy Chaplet** with the intention “to implore from Almighty God the end of the epidemic, relief for those who are afflicted and eternal salvation for those whom the Lord has called to Himself,” **can receive a plenary indulgence each day**. This great news was announced in an **official decree** from the Apostolic Penitentiary on March 20, 2020.
