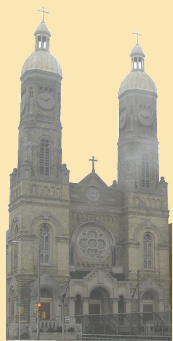
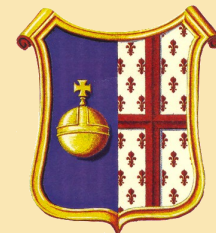

These missals are provided by the Holy Name Society and usually sell for \$39.95. They are offered at the subsidized price of \$20 to encourage people to grow in their appreciation of the traditional Latin Mass.

#### Litany of the Month- October

October is closely associated with Our Lady of the Rosary and Our Lady of Fatima. The feast of Our Lady of the Rosary is celebrated on October 7th and honors the famous battle of Lepanto. The rosary is a crown of roses. In the middle ages, some monks could not read. Instead of reciting the 150 psalms, as the other monks did, they said 150 Our Fathers. In the 11th century, this changed to 150 Hail Marys and was known as Our Lady’s Psalter. St. Dominic received the rosary in its present form directly from the Blessed Virgin Mary in the year 1214. Then, in 1569 Pope St. Pius V set the fifteen mysteries.

The litany for this month is Our Lady of Fatima. Our Lady asked for the recitation of the rosary in each of the six Fatima apparitions, culminating with the miracle of the Sun on October 13, 1917. Please take copies of the litany from the pamphlet rack and recite it as a family.

### CONFIRMATION

Confirmation is one of the seven sacraments of the Church. The rites of initiation are Baptism, Confirmation and Holy Eucharist. Confirmation is also called the sacrament of the Holy Ghost.

The sacrament is administered by the bishop. When it is not possible for the bishop to do all the confirmations in his diocese, a priest may be granted permission to confirm in his absence.

In the sacrament itself, the bishop prays for all those who are to be confirmed. He then makes the sign of the cross on the forehead of each individual, using the oil of chrism. This is followed by a slight slap on the cheek and the words "peace be with thee". At that point each one has become a soldier of Christ and is equipped to go forth and bring others into the Church.

Each confirmandi has his or her own sponsor for confirmation who is not the same person who was the baptismal sponsor. Each also chooses a "confirmation name" which gives the person a special relationship to the saint whose name is selected.
