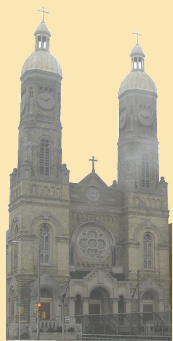
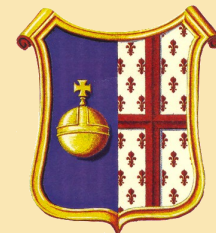

LAMB OF GOD

Above our high altar and above the bas relief of St. Stanislaus is another bas relief. It is of two angels incensing the Lamb of God.

The Pascal Lamb is an important part of the Old Testament. The annual sacrifice of a one year old lamb was planned all year long and was consummated by the ritual eating of a lamb by each family at their Passover meal. This prefigured Jesus, who is the Lamb of God. Jesus, innocent as a lamb, was sacrificed once and for all on Calvary. We receive Our Lord in the Blessed Sacrament. Because of this, there is no longer any need for bloody sacrifice. The angels are giving honor and glory to Jesus by their incense.

LITANY OF THE MONTH – NOVEMBER

The litany of the month for November is for the Souls in Purgatory.

Copies are available in the pamphlet racks in both the north and south vestibules. Please take some home and consider reading it out loud. This can be particularly efficacious if you have a family and make this part of your group prayers. The Church is made up of the Church Militant (that's us), the Church Triumphant in Heaven and the Church Suffering in Purgatory.
